When our daughter Ellen was diagnosed with cancer in 2011, we had heard of THON (Penn State's 46-hour dance marathon), but we were not aware that every year over 16,500 Penn State students fundraise to provide emotional and financial support, spread awareness and ensure funding for critical research – all in pursuit of a cure at the Milton Hershey Children's Hospital. As a result, we never saw a bill for Ellen's treatment because the Four Diamond's Fund picks up the cost for every pediatric cancer patient at Hershey.

After Ellen's surgery and initial treatments in 2011 we were paired with a new THON org, the Hershey Kisses. The Kisses adopted Ellen as one of their own and Ellen immediately latched on to them. The visits from the Kisses were filled with smiles and laughter and Ellen's first THON had her dancing in the stands with her new buddies. Ellen THON'ed with her Kisses for four years and now she watches over them as they continue to dance towards a cure for childhood cancer. THON 2023 experienced a technical difficulty which caused a few minutes "pause" during the "Celebration of Life" slideshow. Of course, we figured it was our girl Ellen, since it had paused on the photo of Ellen and her sidekick Hershey.

Thru THON Nation we are able to give back to the Hershey Kisses, THON and the Four Diamonds Fund. Since 2016 we have raised over \$237,000.
